The project is focussing on the moderation of OT 441 Advanced Occupational Therapy Practice - a capstone unit for the 4th year undergraduate course. This is the first year the unit has been run and involves a complex, scaffolding assessment process culminating in an Advanced Practice Viva (APV). The APV will be conducted over one day and this year will cater for 92 students. The numbers of students will be managed by conducting the APV across eight concurrent panels each comprising of two academic staff from the School and one senior clinician.
